

Esteemed Flier Committee,

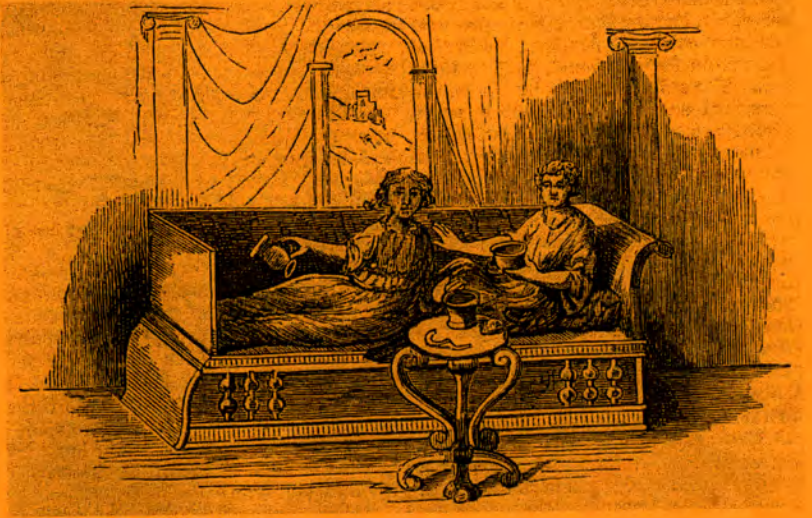
