Pam Houston

Nationally celebrated story writer Pam Houston will read from her work at Stockton State College's Experimental Theater (M-Wing), room M013 on Monday, November 9 at 8 PM. She is the author of the acclaimed *Cowboys Are My Weakness*, which W.W. Norton published in 1992.

Ms. Houston is a part-time river guide and hunting guide, but not a hunter, and her stories often touch on the deep differences between men and women.

In the title story of her book, the narrator says, "I've always had this thing about cowboys, maybe because I was born in New Jersey." Pam Houston was born in New Jersey, and presently lives in Utah where she is completing a Ph.D.
