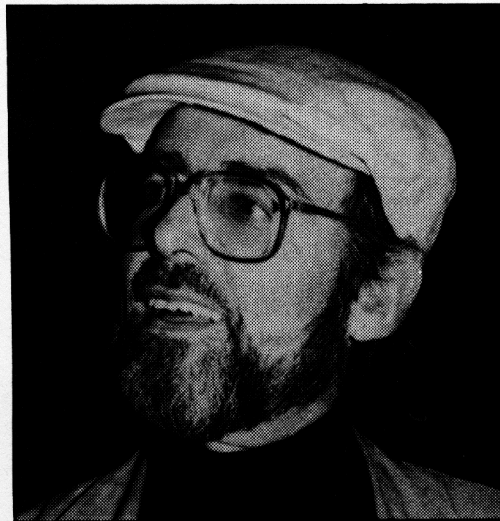

Philip Dacey is the author of five full length collections of poetry, including *Night Shift at the Crucifix Factory*, which won the 1990 Edwin Ford Piper Award from The University of Iowa Press. In addition, he's published numerous chapbooks, of which *The Condom Poems II* is the most recent. He's co-editor of the influential anthology *Strong Measures: Contemporary American Poetry in Traditional Forms*. (Harper & Row).

Mr. Dacey has been awarded Fellowships from The National Endowment for the Arts and the Bush Foundation, to mention just a few of his many awards.

About his new book, Kelly Cherry wrote, "These are troubling, demanding, enlightening poems in which the divine takes on a revelatory human dimension."
