Sueyeun Juliette Lee grew up 3 miles from the CIA. She currently lives in Philadelphia, where she edits Corollary Press, a chapbook series devoted to multi-ethnic experimental writing. Her books include *That Gorgeous Feeling* (Coconut Press) and the recently released *Underground National* (Factory School), in which she suggests that suicide, K-pop, tourism, and atomic explosions have emerged as expressions of the forces upholding untenable national imaginations. She is interested in how poetics may express transnational cultural currents and the self-conscious rendering of history. Sueyeun is slowly at work on a project titled Solar Maximum, which explores cryogenics, solar studies, and imaginations of the apocalypse.
