20 And God said, * Let the Waters bring forth abundantly the living creature that hath life, and soule that may fly aboue the earth in the open firmament of heauen.

21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moueth, which the waters brought forth abundantly after their kinde, and every winged soule after his kinde: and God saw that it was good.

22 And God blessed them, saying, * Be fruitfull, and multiply, and fill the Waters in the Seas, and let soule multiply in the earth.

23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kinde, cattell, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kinde: and it was so.

25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kinde, and cattell after their kinde, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth, after his kinde: and God saw that it was good.

26 And God said, * Let vs make man in our Image, after our likeness: and let them haue dominion ouer the fish of the sea, and ouer the soule of the aire, and ouer the cattell, and ouer all the earth, and ouer every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

27 So God created man in his owne Image, in the Image of God created hee him; * male and female created hee them.

28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, * Be fruitfull, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it, and haue dominion ouer the fish of the sea, and ouer the soule of the aire, and ouer every living thing that mooueth upon the earth.

29 And God said, Behold, I haue given you every herbe bearing seede, which is vpon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yeelding seed, * to you it shall be for meat:

30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every soule of the aire, and to every thing that creepeth vpon the earth,

wherein there is life, I haue giuen every greene herbe for meat: and it was so.

31 And * God saw every thing that hee had made: and behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.
