

## Handout 5.2

Identify verbs, objects or complements, and identify voice. Mark prepositional phrases with parentheses.

1.  $S$   $AV$   $DO$   
She wanted pie. Active voice - Passive = Pie was wanted by her.
2.  $S$   $LV$   $PN$   
It was a simple need. - Intransitive - no voice
3.  $S$   $AV$   $DO$   
(But she wanted a particular type of pie.) Active voice. Passive: *A particular type of pie was wanted by her.*
4.  $S$   $AV$   $DO$  Adverbial  $S$   $AV$   $IO$   $DO$   
She had had grape pie last September (when she gave him that surprise trip to the Finger Lakes.)  
Active voice  
Passive: *Grape pie had been had by her last September.*
5.  $S$   $LV$   $PA$   
(In the baked pie) the grapes smelled out of this world. NO VOICE
6.  $S$   $AV$   $DO$   $AV$   $DO$   $AV$   
(You) Think (of the best peanut butter and jelly sandwich), bake it (in a pie), (but) leave out the peanut butter. Generally in Active voice.
7.  $S$   $LV$   $PA$   
The pie tasted so good.
8.  $S$   $AV$   $IO$   $DO$   $AV$   $DO$   
He gave her a smile and said concord.
9.  $S$   $LV$   $PN$   
Those were the Finger Lake grapes (in the pie.)
10.  $S$   $AV$   $DO$   
(And she badly wanted another.) Active voice. Passive: *Another was badly wanted by her.*
11.  $S$   $PN$   
Luckily, it was September again, pie season.
