Section 1: Basic Demographics (Teams 1, 2, 3, and 4)

Team 1 is responsible for:

- Percent Atlantic County's Population that are Women
- Along with Teams 2, 3 and 4, Team 1 will write the introduction for "Section One: Basic Demographics."

Team 2 is responsible for:

- Racial Demographics of Atlantic County's Women
- Percent of Atlantic County Women that are Hispanic or Latina
- Along with Teams 1, 3 and 4, Team 2 will write the introduction for "Section One: Basic Demographics."

Team 3 is responsible for:

- Percent of Atlantic County Women/Men that Have a Disability
- Along with Teams 1, 2, and 4, Team 3 will write the introduction for "Section One: Basic Demographics."

Team 4 is responsible for:

- Marital Status of Atlantic County Women: never married, widowed, divorced or now married
- Along with Teams 1, 2 and 3, Team 4 will write the introduction for "Section One: Basic Demographics."

Section 2: Political Participation

Team 5 is responsible for:

- Percent of Atlantic County Officeholders that are Women
- Status of a County Task Force or a Commission Focused on the Status of Women

Team 6 is responsible for:
