5. Must have completed at least 3 semesters of college course work.
6. Must be currently enrolled as a student at Stockton.

DUES AND OPPORTUNITIES

Upon admittance to Sigma Tau Delta, you will receive a letter of acceptance and then be required to pay a one-time fee of \$40 for your international dues. This fee entitles you to:
