

## ***Bibliography***

Bibliography: Bibliographia, Greek=Book Writing. 1) The writing of books *obsolete*; 2) the systematic description and history of books, their authorship, printing, publication, editions, etc.; 3) a book containing such details; 4) a list of the books of a particular author, printer, or country, or of those dealing with any particular theme; the literature of a subject (*OED*).

### Three main definitions:

- the study of books as physical objects, i.e. their printing, paper, binding, etc.
- a book, a bibliography, containing lists of books by particular subject headings
- a list of source works appended to scholarly studies that were used to create the study (note the difference between an inclusive bibliography and a specific “works cited” page)
